



MONTANA DECA CAREER DEVELOPMENT CONFERENCE Code of Conduct

The following standards of conduct shall apply to all student participants attending the Montana DECA Career Development Conference, in addition to any standards normally adopted by the school or school district for extracurricular activities.

1. The DECA Chapter Advisor is responsible for participant conduct at all times.
2. Participants must be on time and prepared for all conference activities.
3. Participants must inform the DECA Chapter Advisor of their activities and whereabouts at all times.
4. Participants must wear conference identification badges at all times.
5. Participants may not deface or litter the conference or lodging sites. Individual offenders or his/her chapters will be responsible for payment for any damages to property or furnishings of conference or lodging rooms.
6. Participants must remain on the conference premises unless accompanied by or given permission by the DECA Chapter Advisor.
7. Participants may not possess alcoholic beverages or controlled substances other than prescription medication.
8. Participants must be in their assigned lodging rooms and quiet at curfew. Participants are not permitted in lodging rooms of persons of the opposite sex, except when an advisor is present such as a meeting.
9. Participants may not use any tobacco products at any scheduled conference function or in any area where judges or guests of the conference are located.
10. Participants must wear appropriate business attire at all conference functions, except for scheduled entertainment when casual attire may be worn. Casual attire also is permitted in the hallways near lodging rooms. Sweats are not considered casual or acceptable attire. See second page of this form for definition of business and casual attire. DECA chapter advisors are responsible for enforcement of these dress standards.
11. Participants must observe all applicable convention center and hotel regulations.
12. Participants from cities other than the host site may not ride in private automobiles without permission of the DECA Chapter Advisor.
13. Participants or DECA chapters not observing these standards may be ejected from the conference.
